

Role of Guest Editor

The guest editor must be an expert in the topic of the journal that he or she wishes to guest edit.

The role and tasks of a guest editor are outlined in the points below:

- Finalising the call for papers
- Suggesting authors, books to be reviewed and book reviewers for the issue
- Approving proposals of articles
- Eliminating inadequate and irrelevant articles before the peer review process begins
- Managing the review process with the editor - questioning and giving clarification when necessary
- Making the final selection of articles to be published
- Giving suggestions and direction to the authors prior to a final revision
- Collaborating with the chief editor for the writing of the editorial

The guest editor will appear with his or her photo at the end of the editorial along with PD Dr. Dr. Joerg Tremmel, editor-in-chief.
